# LEADERSHIP FOR RECONCILIATION Sisu Diriya Harmony Societies

The objective of creating 'sisu diriya' harmony societies is to facilitate a reserve of social capital through enabling students to build relationships and network. A special focus is given to selecting and grooming students from the Ordinary and Advanced Level classes to become Social Agents who advocate peace and harmony. 'sisu diriya' harmony societies have also been instrumental in introducing students with special talents and abilities to zonal, provincial, national, and international levels through competitions organized by various institutions.

Schools in Trincomalee, Ampara, Madakalapuwa, Polonnaruwa, Anuradhapura, Mannar and Vavuniya currently host these societies and they have been very productive in terms of building leadership qualities and efficiency in students. 'sisu diriya' harmony societies also harness the administrative skills of students by giving them the opportunity to organize student exhibitions for the Sisu Diriya national programme. Moreover, creations of Sisu Diriya members are published in the 'Nena Guna' magazine, the official monthly publication of the project.

'sisu diriya' harmony societies also provide a means for students from less privileged schools to seek assistance from urban schools with a lot of facilities. For instance on 11th August 2006, a group of students from the district of Anuradhapura visited Ananda College, Colombo with the aim of linking schools in the North and the East with those in Colombo, Kandy and other cities in order to gain access to urban facilities like fine athletic training, highly trained teachers, and an overall better learning experience. Additionally, the students were able to arrange for donations of stationery and clothing.

The sharing of attitudes and values among 'sisu diriya' harmony societies is crucial in facilitating social integration, as well as laying the foundation for a more convivial social

base. These societies also serve the end of minimizing space for future conflicts by reducing economic gaps between different student communities and merging different cultures harmoniously through the various programmes they organize.

In terms of personality development, 'sisu diriya' harmony societies have provided innumerable opportunities for students test and challenge themselves by taking up leadership roles and fulfilling the duties of a leader. Students have also acquired a keen interest in discussing issues of social and political importance thanks to the active encouragement of lively dialogue in these societies, a tendency that will prove to be of much use in moulding a future citizenry that is politically aware and wise.

Establishing 'sisu diriya' harmony societies were took place under 2 stages in 2008, 4 stages in 2009, 2 stages in 2010 and 2 stages in 2011-2012. The O/L s and A/L/s students, teachers, parents, the members of Sri Lanka Foundation Institution and other distinguished people were participated at the Enhancing Knowledge and Virtues: Student Empowerment National Programme in 2008.

And it was also taken steps to encourage talented students for inter-school, provincial, district and national wide competitions.
